Special Topics: Crime Prevention

3-credit course | Fall 2018 (Thursdays 4:00pm-6:30pm)

This course introduces students to the topic of crime prevention, with emphasis on social developmental approaches that address the root causes of crime. It involves a blend of in-class lectures (for the first three weeks) and service learning (in which students learn by doing).

Through reflection assignments, students connect their fieldwork experience to the course content.

Students complete at least 20 hours of fieldwork over the semester (2 hours per week) with the Start2Finish program, which works to support children in grades 3 to 6 on literacy, fitness, and healthy lifestyles.

The fieldwork schedule is flexible (afternoons, Tuesday to Thursday) with location options in the North-End, Spryfield, and Dartmouth.
