VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

Positions require a 2-year commitment; must be 21 years or older:

- **Restorative Justice Session Facilitator:** guides participants through the process by asking questions, ensuring everyone has a chance to be heard and moving the group towards an agreement of repairing harm.
- **Restorative Justice Session Community Representative:** represent communities harmed by criminal activity and express the ripple effect that crime has on a community.
