

**Directions from Stanfield International Airport to Saint Mary's University (923 Robie Street).**

Highway 102 South into Halifax. Do not exit. About 25 minutes.

Drive straight ahead as highway ends. It turns into Bayers Road.

Go to third set of lights - Connaught Avenue. Turn Right.

Follow Connaught Avenue to the very end (through two sets of lights) and turn left at 3 way stop.

Go to first set of lights and turn right onto Oxford Street.

Continue on Oxford to 4 way stop. Go straight. Road turns into Beaufort Avenue.

Continue on Beaufort for a few minutes. Turn left onto Inglis Street.

Go through next set of lights. Saint Mary's covers the city block on your right.

There is 2 hour parking around the University.

You can continue down Inglis Street, past the church, and turn right into the University parking lot.

(Burke is the building on Inglis before the church, with Saint Mary's sign in front).
