

Ground Transportation to/from Halifax Stanfield International Airport

A 30 minute drive from downtown Halifax and 40 minutes from Saint Mary's University, the [Halifax Stanfield International Airport](#) has daily flights connecting to major airports in Canada, US and Europe. All Canadian passengers are required to carry photo identification and US and international travelers require a valid passport. taxi and limousine service: accept all major credit cards. Two recommendations:
