- **Adult Literacy Tutor As an Adult Literacy volunteer:** You will be participating in a once-per-week one-to-one tutoring program focused on learners whose skills range from adults learning sound-letter relationships for the first time to adults reading at a junior high school level.
- **English Language Learning Tutor:** The English Language Learning (ELL) for Adults is a one-to-one and small group volunteer program where adults can improve their English communication skills with help from community volunteers.
