

## Indigenous Visiting Fellow

The Faculty of Arts, Saint Mary's University has secured funding for a four-month visiting fellowship starting either September 1, 2019 or January 1, 2020. The visiting fellowship would be oriented especially to scholars at early to middle stages of their career, but also to community leaders, and highly accomplished individuals in a range of fields related to the Social Sciences, Humanities, and Environmental Studies.

The successful candidate will have a strong background in Indigenous knowledge and methodologies, including the qualification of lived experience, and will demonstrate a commitment to working with Indigenous communities. The visiting fellow would be expected to contribute to the intellectual life of the University during the Fall or Winter term, engaging with various departments, programs, and individuals specifically around the themes of indigeneity, identity and landscape. He/she would make presentations open to students and members of the broader community with a specific focus on learning opportunities for Indigenous students and intercultural education. In line with the approach of the ad hoc committee on curriculum and Indigenous culture in the Faculty of Arts, the activities of the visiting fellow would be developed in consultation with members of Indigenous communities.

Applicants are asked to submit a CV along with an Expression of Interest including a brief outline of a proposed project or program of activities. Applications should also include the names and contact information for three referees.

No salary will be attached to this position, but travel funds (\$5,000), living allowance (\$10,000) and a research stipend (\$10,000) will be provided. The visiting fellow will have access to shared office space and other university resources as required.
