8 MONTH FULL-TIME SESSIONAL APPOINTMENT**

The Department of Mathematics and Computing Science at Saint Mary's University invites applications for a full-time, eight-month sessional position in Mathematics at the rank of Assistant Professor, to begin September 1, 2019. Candidates are preferred to have a PhD in Mathematics and must have demonstrated a strong commitment to teaching along with an active interest in research. The successful candidate will be expected to teach a total of five courses over two academic semesters at the undergraduate level, while also maintaining their research program.

The Faculty of Science, which houses the Department of Mathematics and Computing Science, has gone through significant renewal in the past decade, with many new and active faculty involved in teaching and research. Our facilities have also been renewed and all space housing members of the Faculty of Science and the Department of Mathematics and Computing Science have been recently renovated and upgraded. We are working to establish and build upon areas of distinct research strength, and foster collaborations locally, regionally, and internationally.

Saint Mary's University is located in the historic port city of Halifax, Nova Scotia, a vibrant, urban community of over 350,000 people. Halifax is a major educational centre for Atlantic Canada and is home to five universities. It is conveniently located to recreational areas and to other major urban centres in Canada and the Northeastern United States.
