



# APPROPRIATE ATTIRE FOR ALL LABORATORY USERS

**PROPERLY FITTING** personal protective equipment (PPE) must be worn when **ENTERING** a laboratory or room where **CHEMICALS** or **BIOLOGICALS** are received, stored, or handled.



**KNEE-LENGTH LAB COAT:**  
Worn closed with sleeves down—  
not rolled or pulled up.



**CSA-APPROVED SAFETY GLASSES,  
GOGGLES, OR FACE SHIELD**  
(Prescription eyeglasses or sunglasses  
are not acceptable substitutes)



**TOTAL SKIN COVERAGE:**  
Closed shoes must be worn.  
Pants/skirts/leggings must reach  
the tops of your shoes.  
(NO sandals, crocs, flats without socks,  
shorts, leggings/tights that fall above  
the ankle, short skirts, etc.)



## EXCEPTION (IN CASES WHERE AN OFFICE IS NESTED WITHIN A LABORATORY):

Faculty, staff, students, and visitors may enter the laboratory without PPE, provided they proceed directly to and from that space, and the laboratory supervisor posts signage stating when it is unsafe to do so.
