## **Important message to our insureds**

### **Travel Insurance is now mandatory for Cuba**

If you are headed to Cuba or planning an upcoming trip, please be advised that as of May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, all visitors to Cuba, including Cubans living abroad, are required to have travel health insurance in order to enter the country.

All visitors will have to provide proof of travel health insurance from providers approved by Cuban authorities. Travelers who do not have coverage will be able to purchase one, directly from Cuban vendors at the point of entry.

AXA Assurances and AXA Assistance, through our local office in Mexico, are on the list of insurers approved by the Cuban government.

Consequently, if you are going to Cuba, we recommend that you have the following documents at hand upon your arrival:

- your International Assistance Card
- your insurance booklet, which explains the details of your coverage (if a copy was provided to you by your employer or your association).
